

10 COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT SCCA.....

QUESTION 1 “Who oversees SCCA?”

Answer: Sugar Creek Christian Academy is a ministry of Sugar Creek Missionary Baptist Church. The church selects 5 members to compose the SCCA School Board to oversee the ministry.

QUESTION 2 “Is SCCA recognized by the State of Ohio?”

Answer: YES! SCCA meets all to the required guidelines to be recognized by the Ohio Department of Education as a Non-chartered, Non-tax supported School.

QUESTION 3 “What grade levels are offered at SCCA?”

Answer: SCCA offers preschool through 12th grade.

QUESTION 4 “Do SCCA students have to take State Testing?”

Answer: NO! SCCA is not required to give students state exams.

QUESTION 5 “Do graduates receive a diploma or do they have to get a GED?”

Answer: SCCA graduates receive a diploma that is fully accredited and do not have to take a GED exam.

QUESTION 6 “Can graduates of SCCA go to college?”

Answer: Yes! As a matter of fact, all of our graduates have attended college courses and some have actually received scholarships.

QUESTION 7 “Can SCCA students play sports?”

Answer: Yes! Students can play for their local Little Leagues or Recreational Leagues without any problem. The State of Ohio recently made it possible for our students to participate in extracurricular activities in the public school of their residence if their private school does not offer that activity. For instance, SCCA students grades 7-12 can participate in football, baseball, band, etc in the district that they reside in.

QUESTION 8 “Is SCCA expensive if I have several children?”

Answer: SCCA tuition costs are a fraction of what other area private schools are charging. Actually, SCCA has a wonderful opportunity for families with several children. No family, regardless of how many students enrolled, will pay more than \$550 per month in tuition. This includes Preschool and the Academy. This is an amazing discount and blessing to many families.

QUESTION 9 “When does the school calendar/day begin and end?”

Answer: SCCA’s School Calendar is very similar to local public schools. The year begins mid-August and ends towards the end of May. The School Day officially begins at 8:30am and ends at 3pm. Early drop off and late pick-up can be arranged if needed.

QUESTION 10 “Are SCCA teachers “certified” ?”

Answer: SCCA teachers are Born-Again Christians with a heart for young people and education. They are carefully selected by the School Board and are approved by the Church. They are required to have at least a bachelor’s degree from a recognized university.
